

**TGF Assessment Policy
2005-2006**

I.) The 2005 – 2006 competition year expenses are computed as follows:

- A. Meet entry fees per gymnast (\$35 - \$45): The expected fee per gymnast X number of meets planned.
- B. Team Entry fees: The expected fee per team X number of meets planned.
- C. Coaches Expenses:
 - Lodging - \$90 per day, 2 coaches per room.
 - Airfare - \$250.00 per ticket
 - Car rental - \$45 per day
 - Per diem (meals) – a straight per diem will be added to each coach’s session fee based on the distance traveled to the meet, as follows:
 1. No per diem for a meet occurring within 60 miles of Flips.
 2. \$10 per diem for a meet outside the above area with no overnight stay.
 3. \$20 per diem for a meet with an overnight stay.
 - Session fees - \$30 per session per coach for the first session of the day and \$20 per session per coach for the subsequent sessions on the same day.
 - Mileage reimbursement for use of the coach’s own vehicle will be made at the amount allowed by the Federal Government. Currently this is \$0.4 per mile. Parking fees will also be reimbursed. Drivers are to carry adequate liability insurance for all areas of travel. Expenses such as insurance, repairs, casualty losses, storage, and traffic fines are not reimbursable. Tolls paid for personal or rental vehicles during the course of the trip are allowable with receipts.

II.) The assessment is determined by the total meet expenses divided by the number of gymnasts per group, plus general TGF operating costs.

III.) The estimated assessments will be determined early in the season and adjusted appropriately as actual expenses occur. The following is an estimate of the 2005 – 2006 season.

IV.) The assessment for compulsory team members for the 2005 – 2006 competition year will be paid by check by 4 installments, due no later than the 20th of each month (July-Oct). Do not make payments until you have received a statement. If you haven’t received a statement by the 15th of the month, please contact the treasurer.

V.) The assessment for the optional team members for the 2005 – 2006 competition year will be paid by check in 5 installments, due no later than the 20th of each month (Sept-Jan). Do not make payments until you have received a statement. If you haven’t received a statement by the 15th of the month, please contact the treasurer.

VI.) It is very important that all members pay their assessments on time. Failure to do so could result in withdrawal from meets. If a member finds needs for special consideration, please contact Treasurer immediately so that alternate arrangements can be made. All individual financial matters are confidential.

VII.) It is believed that all members will act for the good of the club in the fundraising efforts. The optional season becomes significantly more expensive as out of state travel occurs. We would hope that all members would maintain their support of the club and continue to participate in all fundraisers even after their annual assessments have been met. We are one team from Level 5 through Level 10.

VIII.) Work Credits for the 2005 – 2006 competition year will be awarded as follows:

- A. Work Out group representative – 10 work credits
- B. Publicity Representative – 10 work credits
- C. Committee Chair – 5-15 work credits based on the time spent as determined by the Board.
- D. Fundraiser Chair – 5-15 work credits based on the time spent as determined by the Board.
- E. Sponsorships – If an individual secures a sponsorship for TGF, they will earn work credits as follows:
 - 1. Friend of Flips (\$300) – 75 work credits
 - 2. Bronze Sponsor (\$1000) – 250 work credits
 - 3. Silver Sponsor (\$2500) – 600 work credits
 - 4. Gold Sponsor (\$5000) – 1000 work credits
- F. Board member – 30 work credits

For every 1 work credit earned, TGF will lower the individual's assessment by \$1. Credits can be carried over to the next competition year; however if a gymnast leaves the gym, any monies/credits left over are forfeited as per the TGF Bylaws.
